SEMESTER DATES

Winter semester

- ▶ Nomination deadline for partners: May 15th
- ▶ Application deadline for students: May 31st

Summer semester

- ▶ Nomination deadline for partners: October 15th
- ▶ Application deadline for students: October 31st

APPLICATION PROCESS

Students have to be nominated through the coordinator of their home university. Please send the students' name, date of birth, email address, field of study as well as study level (BA/MA). We will then send a link to our online application form directly to the students' email address. Students have to fill in the online application form; no further documents need to be sent in hardcopy.

WELCOME GUIDE FOR INCOMING STUDENTS

It contains all important information about a stay at the FH Wien of WKW University of Applied Sciences in Vienna and is available on our website (can be found in the part "Incoming Students").

COURSE OFFER

In general, incoming students may choose among all programmes offered at FH Wien of WKW (with minor restrictions). Students are free to select courses from different semesters (winter semester: semester 1, 3 and 5; summer semester: semester 2, 4 and 6). In principal the degree programmes are taught in German, but some courses are offered in English. In addition, CIEM offers a variety of courses on a higher BA level in the field of International Management. These courses are exclusively held in English and taught by international experts in the respective field. A Course Guide with a complete list of courses offered in English language will be sent to the student after acceptance.

GERMAN LANGUAGES COURSE

So as to participate in a German Language Course (4 ECTS) students need to take a German entry-level test, which will be sent to the partner universities prior to the exchange semester. No additional fees will be charged for the German Language Course.

HOUSING

Accommodation has to be organised by the students themselves. They can either book a room in one of the students' residences like OeAD Housing, ÖJAB, Home4Students, Kolpinghaus... or check the private market for available rooms. Further information can be found in the Welcome Guide. Shortly after the application deadline we also send out an email with some private offers from our outgoing students which would like to rent out their rooms during their stay abroad.

ESITMATES EXPENSES

Per Semester – 5 months:

- ▶ Accommodation: ~ EUR 2.000
- ▶ Food: ~ EUR 900
- ▶ Public Transport: ~ EUR 150 for semester ticket
- ▶ Fee Orientation Week (Membership students union, campus card, printing credit, Membership ESN) – approx.. EUR 45
- ▶ Miscellaneous Expenses: ~ EUR 800 (depending on the student's lifestyle)
