Documents required for application	<p>Students who are interested in studying at Silesian University of Technology as Erasmus exchange students are advised to contact their home university coordinator or International Mobility Office to find out whether a bilateral agreement has been concluded between the two universities, and if so – whether the required programme of studies shall be approved.</p> <p>International Mobility Office of the Silesian University of Technology should receive NOMINATION LETTER from Relations Office of the student's home university firstly.</p> <p><u>Nomination letter should contain following data:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - student's full name and surname, - gender, - valid e-mail address, - receiving faculty at the Silesian University of Technology, - period of stay (winter/summer semester, whole academic year). <p>The following documents are required to be admitted to the University's Mobility Office in Gliwice:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Student Application Form; ▪ Learning Agreement – student should collect 25-30 ECTS credits per semester; ▪ Accommodation Form; ▪ Transcript of Records; ▪ Language proficiency document which confirms English skills and proper level to know you'll be able to follow lectures and pass exams. <p>Download: http://www.polsl.pl/Jednostki/RW4/ic/Strony/files.aspx</p> <p>Before you mail originals do scans and send them electronically in PDF file to Office e-mail box (mobility@polsl.pl)</p> <p>Completed documents should be sent by your institution or yourself to the IMO:</p> <p>International Mobility Office of Silesian University of Technology 2A Akademicka street 44-100 Gliwice, Poland</p>

Average cost of such an offer is about 100€ per month per person, depending on room standard. Double and triple rooms are the most common offer. Kitchen and bathrooms are sometimes common for the whole floor. <p>Expenses</p>	<p>The cost of living in Gliwice is about 300€ per month. Students have access to canteens at the University Campus. Lunch at the university canteen costs about 3-4 €. Breakfasts and dinners are not offered.</p>
<p>Health insurance requirements</p>	<p>Students from EU/EEA countries staying temporarily in the territory of Poland are entitled to free health care on the basis of the European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) or in particular cases on the basis of a special certificate (translated into Polish by sworn translator). You shouldn't forget about insurance against accidents (EHIC is just a health insurance).</p> <p>Students from non-EU/EEA countries should purchase health accidents insurance in their home country, before departure. In case of the ISIC or Euro<26 card, insurance is included in the card and it is not necessary to buy another one unless one wants to increase its scope or value. According to the state health regulations, foreigners have to pay for medical consultation.
