

About the project

The project **Study & CoWork in Vorpommern** is a regional network that seeks to improve the integration of international students and graduates into the economy. It is part of the federal initiative STUDY & WORK.

The network supports international students (and doctoral candidates) on their path to successful completion of their academic degrees and aims to facilitate their entrance into the German and especially regional job market.

Background: This programme is underpinned by current studies. They show that even though there is an increasing lack of highly skilled workers in Germany, the potential represented by international students and graduates is still not being sufficiently realized. And this in spite of international students and graduates being highly qualified, proficient in German and accustomed to regional ways of life. International students are very interested in finding employment in Germany upon completion of their studies. The German economy also needs these graduates. But the transition from study to employment poses a great hurdle for this group. This is where the project Study & CoWork in Vorpommern comes into play.

What we offer

Individual consultation: In Stralsund, Greifswald und Neubrandenburg we offer consultation on: starting a job and job perspectives; job application documents and interviews; internships; job search strategies; contact with businesses; self-employment; recognition of foreign university degrees; questions about residence and work permits; specifics and conventions of professional life in Germany. We also assist students who are interested in voluntary activities and provide information about other forms of support in the region.

Training seminars and workshops: In the project, various kinds of job-related training and workshops are offered. The focus here lies on personal and professional development:

- Intercultural training
- Job application training
- Rhetorical skills and presentation
- Project management
- Strategic networking management

In addition, we offer workshops on setting up a business in Germany.

Information events and excursions: The focus of the information events and guest lectures lies in various aspects of the transition from studying to professional life. Excursions to businesses in Mecklenburg-Vorpommern provide an opportunity to get to know the regional business landscape.

Intensive programme “Studying and working successfully in Germany” (two semesters): At the start of each winter semester, a one year long intensive programme for selected international students and doctoral candidates commences. The participants complete all career-relevant seminar modules and are accompanied individually throughout the duration of the intensive programme. They receive needs-based coaching and support, especially while establishing their own professional networks and searching for an internship.
